ACT

**to validate certain procedural defects in relation to the elections to  
be held for the Sikh Gurdwaras Committees.**

Be it enacted by the State Legislature of Punjab in the Fifth year of  
the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sikh Gurdwaras Committees  
Election (Validation) Act, 1954.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

No election to a Sikh Gurdwaras Committee shall be void merely  
on the ground that the Returning Officer for any such Committee  
constituency was not appointed in accordance with the rules made under  
the Punjab Sikh Gurdwaras Act, 1925 (Punjab Act 8 of 1925).
