Be it enacted by the Legislative Ascembly of the State of Andhra Dradesh in the Thirty-minth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1 (1) This Act may be called the short title Andbra Pradesh University Acts (Amendment) and commence-Act, 1988. ment.
