## THE ANDHRA PRADESH (ANDHRA AREA) DISTRICT POLICE ACT, 1989\*

ACT No. 12 OF 1989.

[25th April, 1989.]

An Act to amend the Andhra Pradesh (Andhra Area) District Police Act, 1859.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Fortieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Short title Andhra Pradesh (Andhra Area) District and commence-Police (Amendment) Act, 1989.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, appoint.

2. In the Andhra Pradesh (Andhra Area) District Police Act, 1859 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in section 1, for the definition 'Superior Police' the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"Superior Police":- the expression "Superior Police" shall mean the Director General of Police, the Inspector General of Police, Deputy Inspector General of Police, Commissioner of Police, District Superintendent Deputy Commissioner of Police, of Police. Assistant Commissioner of Police, Assistant Superintendent of Police and Deputy Superintendent of Police".

Substitution 3. Throughout the principal Act, except of the words in section 1, for the words "Inspector General Director of Police", wherever it occurs, the words "Director General of Police" shall be sub-Police' for stituted. 'Inspector
