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THE ANDHRA PRADESH PUBLIC SECTOR UNDER-TAKINGS (RECONSTITUTION OF MANAGEMENT) ACT, 1996.*

ACT NO. 4 OF 1996.

[20th January, 1996]

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR EFFECTIVE FUNCTION-ING OF PUBLIC SECTOR UNDERTAKINGS BY RECONSTITUTING THEIR MANAGEMENT AND FOR THE NATIERS CONNECTED THEREWITH OR INGIDENTAL THERETO.

Whereas there are a number of non-trading public sector undertakings functioning as instrumentalities of the

State under various branches of administration within the State of Andhra Pradesh:

And whereas, immediate action found to be essential in public interest to accelerate revamping of management of such bodies to function as bodies responsive to the aspirations and needs of the people:

And whereas, in the notifications issued in G.S.R.No.906, dated the 30th July, 1981, G.S.R.No.577 (E), dated the 16th July, 1985, and G.S.R.No.579(E), dated the 16th July, 1985, and also in certain other notifications issued from time to time, the Government of India have exempted all the Government companies from various provisions of the Central Act 1 Companies Act, 1956 under section 620 of the said Act:

> Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh, in the Forty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- (c) "Public Sector Undertaking" means a public sector undertaking specified in the Schedule to this Act;
- (d) "Schedule" means the Schedule appended to this Act.

 - (2) Where a notification has been issued under sub-section (1), there shall,

unless the notification is in the magnetime rescinded, be introduced in the Legislative Assembly, as soon as may be. but in any case during the next session of the Legislative Assembly following the date of the issue of the notification, a Bill on behalf of the Government to give effect to the alteration, addition or cancellation as the case may be, of the Schedule specifiled in the notification, and the notification cease to have effect when such Bill law, whether with or without. becomes modifications but without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done thereunder:

Provided that if the notification under sub-section (1) is issued when the Legislative Assembly is in session, such a Bill shall be introduced in the Legislative Assembly during that session:

Provided further that where for any reason a Bill as aforesaid does not become law within six months from the date of its introduction in the Legislative Assembly, the notification shall cease to have effect on the expiration of the said period of six months.
