AN ACT PROVIDE FOR THE TAKING OVER OF THE MANAGEMENT OF THE AFFAIRS OF THE UTKAL UNIVERSITY FOR A LIMITED PERIOD IN ORDER TO SECURE PROPER MANAGEMENT OF THE SAME

B_B it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Orissa in the Twenty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Utkal Univer-Short title sity (Taking Over of Management) Act, 1974.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 30th day of July, 1974.
- 2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise Definitions requires:—
 - (a) "Administrator" means the Administrator appointed under section 3;
 - (b) "notified order" means an order notified in the Official Gazette under section 3;

- 3. (1) The State Government may, by notified Administraorder, appoint an Officer (hereinafter referred to as tor to take over manathe "Administrator") to take over the management gement of the affairs of of the affairs of the University. the University.
 - (2) A notified order issued under sub-section (1) shall remain in force for a period of one year:

Provided that if the State Government are of opinion that in order to secure the proper management of the affairs of the University, it is expedient that such notified order should continue in force after. the expiry of the period of one year as aforesaid, they, may from time to time, issue directions for such continuance for such period, not exceeding one year at a time, as may be specified in the directions; but. such notified order shall in no case remain in force for more athan a stotal period of three eyears; and where any such direction is issued, a copyrithereof; shall be laid, as soon as may be, before the State Legislature.

- 4. (1) On the issue of a notified order under section 3 appointing an Administrator to take over order issued the management of the affairs of the University.
 - (a) the Senate and the Syndicate shall be deemed to have been superseded and the members thereof holding office immediately before the issue of the notified order shall be deemed to have vacated their offices as such;
 - (b) the offices of the members of the Senate for life shall remain in abeyance during the continuance, of the notified order in

- (c) the Vice-Chancellor shall be deemed to have vacated his office as such;
- (d) the Administrator shall exercise the powers: and perform the functions of the Senate. Syndicate and the Vice-Chancellor under

- (2) Subject to the provisions contained in this Act and the provisions contained in the University Act, the Statutes and the Regulations, the Administrator shall take such steps as may be necessary for the efficient management of the affairs of the University.

- 6. Subject to the provisions contained in this Application Act, the University Act, the Statutes and Regulations University shall continue to apply to the University in the same Act.

 - 9. Subject to the provisions of this Act; the State Power of Government may give such directions to the Admini-State Government strator as they may deem fit for the proper manage to give ment of the affairs of the University and the Admini-directions. strator shall comply with such directions.

10. '[(1)] The Administrator shall take all necefor reconstitution of the Senate and the tution of the Syndicate and for the appointment of the Vice-Chancellor so that the members of the said authorities and the Vice-Chancellor can assume office upon the expiry of the notified order.

> ²[provided that the State Government may, in consultation with the chancellor, appoint the officer acting as the Administrator to be the Vice-chancellar of the University with effect from the date of expiry of the notified order for such term, not exceeding three years, as they may fix.]

- ³[(2) All elections and nominations necessary for the purposes of such reconstitution or appointment as aforesaid shall be held in advance in accordance with the provisions of the University Act and the Statutes saiframed thereunder.
 - (3) All persons who are to take part at any such election by virtue of holding office as members of any of the said authorities shall, notwithstanding the fact that they have not assumed such office, be eligible to take such part.]

Repeal and savings.

11. (1) The Utkal University (Taking Over of Orissa Management) Ordinance, 1974 and the Utkal Univer-Ordinance sity (Taking Over of Management) (Amendment) 1974. Ordinance, 1974 are hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any order notified, any direction given, anything done or any action taken under the Ordinances so repealed shall be deemed to have been notified, given, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of this Act
