An Act further to assend the Audira Pradesh Educational Institutions Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fec.) Act, 1983

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Forty-third year of the Republic of India as follows:

- 1. Short title.—This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capital tion Fee) (Amendment) Act. 1992.
- 2. Insertion of new section 3A.—In the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983, after section 3, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—
- "3A. Special Provision in respect of unadded private educational institutions.—No twithstanding anything contained in section 3 but subject to such rules as may be unade in this behalf and the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974, it shall be lawful for the management of any unaided private engineering college, medical college, dental college and such other class of unaided educational institutions as may be notified by the Government in this behalf to admit students into such colleges or educational institutions to the extent of one half of the total number of seats from among those who have qualified in the common entrance test or in the qualifying examination, as the case may be referred to in sub-section (1) of section 3 irrespectibe of tee ranking assigned to them in such test or examination and nothing contained in section 5 shall apply to such admissions."

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature, received the assent of the Governor on the 23rd September, 2009 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 25th September, 2009 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:-

ACT No. 17 OF 2009.

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE ANDHRA PRADESH EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS (REGULATION OF ADMISSIONS AND PROHIBITION OF CAPITATION FEE) ACT, 1983.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Sixtieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title and commencement.

2

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) (Amendment) Act, 2009.
- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th January, 2009.

Amendment of Section 3. Act 5 of 1983.

2. In the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1983, in section 3, in sub-section (1) for the existing proviso the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"Provided that admission into Agriculture, Dental, Engineering, Medical, Pharmacy and Veterinary Colleges shall be made on the basis of ranking assigned by giving weightage to the marks secured in the relevant group subjects namely, Biology, Physics, Chemistry or Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, as the case may be, in the Intermediate Public Examination or equivalent Examination and weightage to the marks secured in the common entrance test as may be prescribed."

Repeal of Ordinance No. 3 of 2009.

3. The Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Prohibition of Capitation Fee) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2009 is hereby repealed.
