No. Home (A) A 9-55/92.—Whereas, the Central Government in exercise of the powers vested in it under section 19 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (37 of 1967) has directed vide S.C. No. 906 (C), dated 10-12-1992 that all the powers which are exercisable by the Central Government under section 7 and 8 of the aforesaid Acte shall also be exercisable by the State Government and authorised the State Government further to direct that all such powers may also bs/exercised by the Commissioners of Police and District Magistrate Deputy Commissioners/District Collectors;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of said Act, read with the Central Government Notification No. 906(C), dated 10-12-1992, the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to direct that subject to any orders and directions which may be given by the Central or State Government, all the powers which are exercisable alby the State Government under sections 7 and 8 of the aforesaid Act shill also be exercised by the District Magistrates, within their respective jurisdictions.

An Act to amend of Usurious Loans Act, 1918 (Central Act No. 10 of 1918) in it application to the [State] of Himachal Pradesh.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Himachal Pradesh in the Twentieth Year of the Republic of India as follows.—

- 1. Short title and extent.—(1) This Act may be called the Usurious Loans (Himachal Pradesh Amendment) Act, 1969.
 - (2) It shall extend to the whole of Himachal Pradesh.
- 2. Amendment of section 2.—In clause (a) of sub-section (3) of section 2 of the Usurious Loans Act, 1918 (10 of 1918) in its application to Himachal Pradesh, the following words shall be inserted between the words "loans made" and the words "after the commencement of this Act", namely:—

"whether before or"

3. Repeal and savings.—The Usurious Loans (East Punjab Amendment) Act, 1948 (4 of 1948), as in force in the areas added to Himachal Pradesh under section 5 of the Punjab Re-organisation Act, 1966, is hereby repealed:

Provided that anything done or any action taken under the said Act shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.
