An Act to amend the Provincial Small Cause Courts Act, 1887 (Central Act 9 of 1887) in its application to the ¹[State] of Himachal Pradesh.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Himachal Pradesh in the Twentieth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

1. Short title and extent.—(1) This Act may be called the Provincial Small Cause Courts (Himachal Pradesh Amendment) Act, 1969.

(2) It shall extend to the whole of Himachal Pradesh.

2. Amendment of section 15 of Central Act 9 of 1887.—In section 15 of the Provincial Small Cause Courts Act, 1887 (Central Act No. 9 of 1887) in its application to the ¹[State] of Himachal Pradesh:—

(1) In sub-section (2), for the words “five hundred”, the words “two thousand” shall be substituted; and

(2) Sub-section (3) shall be omitted.

3. Repeal and savings.—The Provincial Small Cause Courts (Punjab Amendment) Act, 1966 (3 of 1966) as in force in the areas added to Himachal Pradesh under section 5 of the Punjab Re-organisation Act, 1966 (31 of 1966) is hereby repealed:

Provided that anything done or any action taken under the said Act shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.

No. HHC/Admn. 6/28/76.—In exercise of the powers vested in it under section 13 of the Himachal Pradesh Courts Act, 1976 (Act No. 23 of 1976) read with the Provincial Small Cause Courts (Himachal Pradesh Amendment) Act, 1969 (Act No. IV of 1970), the High Court of Himachal Pradesh in supersession of all previous notifications, issued in this behalf, is pleased to confer, on all the Senior Sub-Judges of First Class, who have held that post for a period of not less than five years, small cause jurisdiction for the trial of the suits upto the value of Rs. 2,000/- within the local limits of their respective territorial jurisdiction, with effect from the date of the publication of this notification in Himachal Pradesh Rajpatra.
