#### An Act to validate the registration of documents in certain cantonment sub-districts in <sup>2</sup>[Punjab]

Whereas it is necessary to remove doubts as to the validity of registration of documents purporting to be registered in certain cantonmet sub-districts in 2[Punjab] and whereas the previous sanction of the Governor-General under sub-section (3) of section 80-A of the Government of India Act has been obtained; It is hereby enacted as follows :-

Preamble

1. (1) This Act may be called the Punjab Registra - Short title, exten commence tion Validating Act, 1930.

(2) It extends to <sup>3</sup>Punjab.

# (3) It shall come into force at once.

- Validation of acts of registering officers purporting of registering officers purporting ing to act as Sub-Registrars of the cantonment sub-districts to act as Sub-mentioned in the first column of the schedule during the Registrars in respect of certain period given opposite each sub-district in the second colregistered documn of the Schedule shall be valid and shall be deemed to have been validly performed on and from the dates of their performance as though the appointment of the persons aforesaid had been duly made in accordance with the law relating to registration in force during the period specified opposite each sub-district in the Schedule.
- Validation of the records of the aforesaid regis- rality of acts validated by the foregoing provision—
  - (a) all documents registered by registering officers in the sub-disricts aforesaid during the periods specified shall be deemed to have been validly registered on the dates of their registration;
  - (b) all entries and indexes relating to the documents registered as aforesaid made in the register-books in the manner provided by Part XI of the Indian Registration Act, 1908, shall be deemed to have been validly made;
  - (c) all copies of such registered documents which have been duly signed and sealed by the registering officers aforesaid in the manner required by section 57 of the Indian Registration Act, 1908, shall be admissible for the purpose of proving the contents of the original documents.
- Indemnity for registering officers acting bona fide to the contrary, no registering officer as is described in in official cap<sup>3</sup>- section 2 shall be liable in any suit or proceeding for any claim or demand by reason of anything in good faith done or refused by him in his official capacity.
