## <sup>1</sup>THE PUNJAB LAWS (APPLICATION) ACT, 1957

### (PUNJAB ACT NO. 33 OF 1957)

(Received the assent of the Governor of Punjab on the 7th November, 1957 and was first published for general information in the Punjab Government Gazette (Extraordinary) dated the 11th November, 1957.)

An Act to enforce in the new State of Punjab certain laws applicable in the State of Punjab before the 1st of November, 1956.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Punjab in the Eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :--

1. (1) This Act may be called the Punjab Laws (Application) Act, 1957.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st November, 1956.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,-

- (a) appointed day' means the first day of November. 1956;
- (b) 'new State' means the State of Punjab as formed under section 11 of the States Reorganisation Act, 1956 (37 of 1956);
- (c) 'Punjab State' means the territories which, immediately before the 1st November, 1956, were comprised in the State of Punjab.

3. (1) The Acts specified in the Schedule together with all rules, orders and notifications made thereunder pertaining to the Punjab State

shall apply and shall be deemed always to have applied in regard to similar institutions, authorities and dignitaries of the new State.

(2) With effect from the commencement of this Act the Acts mentioned in the Schedule shall be amended as specified therein

4. If any difficulty arises in giving effect in the new State to the provisions of any Act mentioned in the Schedule, the State Government may, by order notified in the Official Gazette, make such provisions or give such directions as appear to it necessary for the removal of the difficulty.

5. Nothing contained in this Act shall affect the provisions of the Punjab Legislative Assembly (Allowances of Members) Ordinance, 1957 (4 of 1957), and the Punjab Legislative Council (Allowances of Members) Ordinance, 1957 (5 of 1957).
