[THE '(TAMIL NADU) INDIAN PORTS (AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1925.]

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 21st December 1925, and that of the Governor-General on the 12th January 1926; the assent of the Governor-General was first published in the Fort St. George Gazette of the 26th January 1926.)

An Act to amend the Indian Ports Act, 1908, in its application to the ³[State of Tamil Nadu].

Preproble.

FOREIGN TO COLD IN

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Indian Ports Act, 1908, in its application to the ³[State of Tamil Nadu], and whereas the previous sanction of the Governor General has been obtained to the passing of this Act; It is hereby exacted as follows:—

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be called the "1[Tamil Nadu] Indian Ports (Amendment) Act, 1925".
- Amendment of 2. For clause (a) of Explanation 1 to Part II of Part II of the First Schedule to the Indian Ports Act, 1908, of Central Act the following class shall be substituted, namely:—XV of 1908.
 - "Ship" means a vessel propelled solely by wind power and "steamer" any vessel other than a ship.

This Act was extended to the Kanyakumari district and the Shencottah taluk of the Tirunelveli district by section 3 of, and the First Schedule to, the Tamil Nadu (Transferred Territory) Extension of Laws Act, 1960 (Tamil Nadu Act 23 of 1960) repealing the corresponding law in force in that territory.

These words were abbitituted for the word "Madras" by the Tamil Nadu Adaptation of Laws Order, 1969, as amended by the Tamil Nadu Adaptation of Laws (Second Amendment) Order, 1969, which came into force on the 14th January 1969.

(Tamil Nadu Amendment)

TAMIL NADU ACT NO. 19 OF 1975.*

THE INDIAN PORTS (TAMIL NADU AMEND-MENT) ACT, 1975.

[Received the assent of the President on the 2nd July 1975, first published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary on the 7th July 1975 (Aani 23, Iratchasa (2006—Tiruvalluvar Aandu)).]

An Act further to amend the Indian Ports Act, 1908, in its application to the State of Tamil Nadu.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Indian Ports (Tamil Short title, extent and commencement.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of the State of Tamil Nadu.
- (3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.
- 2. In this Act "minor port" means any port not Definition. being—
- (i) a major port as defined in the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act XV of 1908), or
 - (ii) the port of Tuticorin.
- 3. The provisions of sections 36, 37, 49 and 50 of the Amendment of Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act XV of 1908) (herein-Central Act XV after referred to as the principal Act), shall apply in relation of 1908. to minor ports in the State of Tamil Nadu with the following modifications, namely:—
- (1) for section 36, the following section shall be substituted, namely:—
- "36. Power of Government to appoint officer or body of persons to receive port dues.—The State Government shall appoint some officer or body of persons at every port at

which any dues, fees or other charges are authorised to be taken by or under this Act to receive the same. The amount so received shall be credited to the Consolidated Fund of the State.";

(2) in section 37,—

- (a) in sub-section (1), the portion beginning with the words "and thereupon all moneys" and ending with the words "any of the ports" shall be omitted:
- (b) for sub-section (2), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—
- "(2) Where ports are grouped by or under this Act, the State Government may exercise its authority under section 34 as regards all the ports in the group collectively or as regards any of them separately.";

(3) in section 49,—

- (a) in sub-section (1), the following sentence shall be added at the end, namely:—
 - "Such port dues shall be called hospital port dues.";
 - (b) sub-section (2) shall be omitted;
 - (4) in section 50, sub-section (3) shall be omitted.

Insertion of new section 50-A in Central Act XVof 1908.

- 4. After section 50 of the principal Act, the following section shall be inserted, namely:—
- "50-A. Abolition of port fund.—The port fund constituted under this Act for the ports (other than a major port or the port of Tuticorin) in the State of Tamil Nadu shall, on the commencement of the Indian Ports (Tamil Nadu Amendment) Act, 1975, stand abolished, and the balances to the credit of the said fund at such commencement shall be credited to the Consolidated Fund of the State."
- Repeal. 5. The Tamil Nadu Minor Ports Fund Act, 1938 (Tamil Nadu Act XIX of 1938) is hereby repealed.
