WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Cotton ^{Central}
Transport Act, 1923, in its application to the ³[State ^{Act III}
of Tamil Nadu], for the purpose hereinafter appear- ^{of 1923.}
ing ; It is hereby enacted as follows :—

Short title
and extent.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Cotton Trans-
port (¹[Tamil Nadu] Amendment) Act, 1948.

(2) It extends to the whole of the ⁴[State of
Tamil Nadu].

2. In section 7, sub-section (2), of the Cotton
Transport Act, 1923, for the words "five hundred ^{Central}
rupees", the words "ten thousand rupees" shall be ^{Act III}
