THE PUDUKKOTTAI (SETTLEMENT OF INAMS) ACT, 1955.I

(Received the assent of the Governor on the 14th September 1955; first published in the Fort St. George Gazette on the 21st September 1955.]

An Act to provide for the settlement of inams in the merged territory of Pudukkottai in the 3[State of Tamil Nadu.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the settlement of inams in the merged territory of Pudukkottai in the 3[State of Tamil Nadul;

BE it enacted in the Sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

I. (1) This Act may be called the Pudukkottai (Settle-short title ment of Inams) Act, 1955.

- (2) It shall come into force on *such date as the State Government may, by notification in the Fort St. George Gazette **appoint.
