THE TAMIL NADU CULTIVATING TENANTS PROTECTION AND PAYMENT OF FAIR RENT (EXTENSION TO SHENCOTTAH TALUK) ACT, 1959.

Received the assent of the Governor on the 19th February 1959, first published in the Fort St. George Gazette on the 2nd March 1960 (Phalguna 12, 1881).]

An Act to extend the ¹[Tamil Nadu] Cultivating Tenants Protection Act, 1955, and the ¹[Tamil Nadu] Cultivating Tenants (Payment of Fair Rent) Act 1956, to the Shencottah taluk of the Tirunelveli district.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide that the '[Tamil Nadu] Cultivating Tenants Protection Act, 1955 (1 [Tamil Nadu] Act XXV of 1955), and the ¹[Tamil Nadu] Cultivating Tenants (Payment of Fair Rent) Act, 1956 (¹[Tamil Nadu] Act XXIV of 1956), should be extended to, and by virtue of such extension should be in force in, the Shencottah taluk of the Tirunelveli district;

BE it enacted in the Tenth Year of the Republic of India as follows :---

(1) This Act may be called the [Tamil Nadu] 1. Cultivating Tenants Protection and Payment of Fair Rent (Extension to Shencottah Taluk) Act, 1959.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. The ²[Tamil Nadu] Cultivating Tenants Protection Extension of Act, 1955 (²[Tamil Nadu] Act XXV of 1955), and the ²[Tamil Nadu Acts] Nadu] Cultivating Tenants (Payment of Fair Rent) Act, Nadu Acts] Nadu] Cultivating Tenants (Payment of Fair Rent) Act, XXV of 1956 (²[Tamil Nadu] Act XXIV of 1956), as in force 1955 and immediately before the commencement of this Act (herein-XXIV of after referred to as the said Acts) are hereby extended to, 1956 to and shall be in force in, the Shencottah taluk of the Tirunelveli district (hereinafter referred to as the said taluk).

3. Any law corresponding to either of the said Acts Repeal of in force in the said taluk immediately before the commence- corresponment of this Act (hereinafter referred to as the corresponding ding laws. law) shall stand repealed on such commencement.

4. (1) The repeal, by section 3, of the corresponding Savings. law shall not affect—

(a) the previous operation of the corresponding law or anything done or duly suffered thereunder ; or

(b) any penalty, forefeiture or punishment incurred in respect of any offence committed against the corresponding law; or

(c) any investigation, legal proceeding or remedy in respect of any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment as aforesaid;

and any such investigation, legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced and any such penalty, forfeiture or punishment may be imposed as if this Act had not been passed.

(2) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (1), anything done or any action taken including any appointment or delegation made, notification, order, instruction or direction issued, rule, regulation or form framed, certificate granted or registration effected under the corresponding law shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the said Acts and shall continue in force accordingly, unless and until superseded by anything done or any action taken under the said Acts.

Application of 5. Unless the context otherwise requires, the ²[Tamil **YTamil Nadu**] General Clauses Act, 1891 (²[Tamil Nadu] Act I of Act] I of 1891. 1891), shall apply for the interpretation of the said Acts as extended to, and in force in, the said taluk.
