THE INDUSTRIAL EMPLOYMENT (STANDING ORDERS) (ITAMIL NADU) AMENDMENT) ACT, 1960.

[Received the assent of the President on the 21st October 1960; first published in the Fort St. George Gazette on the 2nd November 1960 (Kartika 11, 1882).]

An Act further to amend the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946, in its application to the ³[State of Tamil Nadu].

Whereas it is expedient further to amend the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 (Central Act XX of 1946), in its application to the ³[State of Tamil Nadu] for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

BE it enacted in the Eleventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Industrial Employ-Short title, ment (Standing Orders) ¹[Tamil Nadu] Amendment Act, commence-ment.
 - (2) It extends to the whole of the ³[State of Tamil Nadu].
- (3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

Amendment 2. To clause (c) of section 2 of the Industrial Employof section 2, ment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 (Central Act XX of 1946),
Central Act the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

"Provided that the State Government may, in relation to industrial establishments in respect of which it is the appropriate Government, appoint, by notification in the Official Gazette, any officer subordinate to the Labour Commissioner to exercise, in such area as may be specified in the notification, the functions of a Certifying Officer under this Act, and any other appointed as aforesaid may exercise those functions, whether or not the Labour Commissioner is absent."
