An Act to provide for the continuance of the <sup>1</sup>[Tamil Nadu]  
Cultivating Tenants Protection Act, 1955.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of the <sup>3</sup>[State of Tamil  
Nadu] in the Fifteenth Year of the Republic of India as  
follows :—

1. This Act may be called the <sup>1</sup>[Tamil Nadu] Cultiva- Short title  
ting Tenants Protection (Continuance) Act, 1965.

2. The <sup>2</sup>[Tamil Nadu] Cultivating Tenants Protection <sup>4</sup>[Tamil Nadu  
Act, 1955 (<sup>1</sup>[Tamil Nadu] Act XXV of 1955) (hereinafter Act] XXV of  
referred to as the principal Act) shall, as amended by 1965 to be  
this Act, become a permanent Act. a permanent
