An Act to repeal the Madras Land Revenue and Water-
cess (Surcharge) Act, 1965.

Enacted by the Legislature of the ³[State of Tamil
Nadu] in the Eighteenth Year of the Republic of India as
follows:—

(1) This Act may be called the ⁴[Tamil Nadu] Land Revenue and Water-cess (Surcharge) (Repeal) Act, 1967. Short title and
commencement.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the
1st day of July 1966.

2. The Madras Land Revenue and Water-cess (Surcharge) Act, 1965 (Madras Act 34 of 1965) is hereby repealed. Repeal of
Madras Act 34
of 1965.
