(First published, after having received the assent of the Governor in the "Gujarat Government Gazette" on the 7th February 1962.)

An Act further to amend the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1958.

It is hereby enacted in the Twelfth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforce-Short title. ment) (Gujarat Amendment) Act, 1961.

Bom. 2. For sub-section (6) of section 17 of the Bombay Weights and Measures Amendment **LXIX** (Enforcement) Act, 1958, the following shall be substituted, namely:— of Bom. 1958. LXIX of 1958.

"(6) For the purpose or such inspection, seizure or detention, an Inspector may, at all reasonable times, enter and search, with such assistance as may be required, any place where weights, measures or weighing or measuring instruments are used or kept for use in transactions for trade or commerce or in which he has reason to believe that an offence under this Act has been or is being committed, and take such action as he is authorised to take under the foregoing provisions of this section.".

GUJARAT ACT NO. XLVII OF 1963.

(First published, after having received the assent of the Governor in the "Gujarat Government Gazette" on the 12th November, 1963).

An Act further to amend the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1958.

It is hereby enacted in the Fourteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows :---

1. This Act may be called the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Short title. (Gujarat Amendment) Act, 1963.

Bom. 2. In section 2 of the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, Amendment LXIX 1958 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), after clause (i), the following of Bom. 1958. clause shall be inserted, namely :--LXIX of 1958.

IV-Extra-60 (Lino)

"(ii) "use in transaction for trade or commerce" means use for the purpose of determination or declaration of the quantity of anything in terms of measurement of length, area, volume, capacity or weight in relation to,---

(a) any contract, whether by way of sale, exchange or otherwise; or

(b) any payment, whether by^{3} way of royalty, toll, duty or any other dues connected with or forming part of such transaction;".

3. In section 3 of principal Act,-

(i) in sub-section (I), for the words "the working standards, and special sets of working standards in relation to bullion and precious stones may also be prepared" the words "the working standards" shall be substituted;

(ii) in sub-section (4), the proviso shall be deleted.

4. In section 7 of the principal Act, for sub-section (1), the following subsection shall be substituted, namely :---

"(1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law or any custom, usage or practice in any area or in respect of any class of goods or undertakings where or in respect of which this Act has come into force, no unit of mass or measure other than the standard weights or measures shall be used in any transactions for trade or commerce, or in any dealing or contract or for any work to be done or goods to be sold or delivered, or be kept in any premises where such transactions are usually conducted.".

5. In section 14 of the principal Act, after the existing proviso, the following Amendment of section 14 proviso shall be inserted, namely :--of Bom.

"Provided further that the State Government may, if it is satisfied that the size of any class of such packages or containers renders it impracticable to comply with the provisions of this section, by notification in the Official Gazette, exempt such class from the operation of this section.".

In section 23 of the principal Act, after the words "other than one of the of section 23 standard weights or measures" the words, brackets and figures "or whoever after XLVII the commencement of the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) (Gujarat of 1963, Amendment) Act, 1963 keeps any unit of mass or measure other than the standard weights or measures in any premises where such transactions are usually conducted" shall be inserted.

7. After section 37 of the principal Act, the following section shall be inserted, Insertion of new section namely :---

37A in Bom. LXIX of 1958.

Composition of offences.

"37A. (1) Any offence punishable under section 23, section 24, section 25, section 27, section 28, section 32 or section 34 other than a second or a subsequent offence under section 23, or section 25, may, either before or after the institution of the prosecution, be compounded by the State Government on payment of such sum as the State Government thinks fit.

(1) Where in a trial of an offence under section 29, it is proved that the weight or measure or weighing or measuring instrument in respect of which the offence is alleged to have been committed by an accused person was false and was used by the accused person, the Court shall presume, until the contrary is proved, that the accused person knew that the weight or measure or, as the case may be, the weighing or measuring instrument was false and that he used the same fraudulently.

(2) Where in a trial of an offence under section 30, it is proved that the weight or measure or weighing or measuring instrument in respect of which the offence is alleged to have been committed by the accused person was false and was in the possession of the accused person the court shall presume, until the contrary is proved, that the accused person knew that the weight or measure or, as the case may be, the weighing or measuring instrument was false and that he intended to use the same fraudulently.".

An Act further to amend the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act. 1958.

It is hereby enacted in the Nineteenth Year of the Republic of India as tollows :--

1. This Act may be called the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Short title. (Gujarat Amendment) Act, 1967.

2. In section 2 of the Bombay Weights and Measures (Enforcement) Act, 1958 Amondment Bom. of section 2 LXIX (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act")of Bom. LXIX of of 1958, 1958.

Penalty for delivoring article in quantity less than or receiving article in quantity more than the quantity fixed by contract. "32 (1) Whoever in selling any article by weight or measure delivers or causes to be delivered to the purchaser any quantity of that article, which is less than the quantity fixed by the weight or measure by which the contract or dealing in respect of that article has been made shall, if the deficiency exceeds the prescribed limit of error, be punished with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees.

(2) Whoever in buying any article by weight or measure demands or receives or causes to be demanded or received any quantity of that article in excess of the quantity fixed by the weight or measure by which the contract or dealing in respect of that article has been made, shall be punished with fine which may extend to five hundred rupees."
