GUJARAT ACT NO. XXVIII OF 1963.

[First published, after having received the assent of the President in the Guiarat Government Gazette on 24th May 1963.].

An Act to extend the Bombay Registration of Marriages Act, 1953. to the rest of the State of Gujarat.

It is hereby enacted in the Fourteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows: ---

1. (1) This Act may be called the Bombay Registration of Marriages (Gujarat Short Extension and Amendment) Act, 1963.

- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.
- 2. In section 1 of the Bombay Registration of Marriages Act, 1953 (herein- Amendment after referred to as "the principal Act"),---

- (i) for sub-section (2), the following shall be substituted, namely:—
 - "(2) It extends to the whole of the State of Gujarat.".
- (ii) to sub-section (3), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:—

"Provided that in that part of the State to which this Act is extended by the Bonibay Registration of Marriages (Gujarat Extension and Amendment)

Act, 1963, this section shall come into force at once and the remaining provisions of this Act shall come into force in such areas and on such date as XXVIIII the State Government may, by like notification, appoint."

Amendment 3. In section 7 of the principal Act, for the words "the Bombay area of the of section State of Gujarat", the words "this State" shall be substituted.
