THE BOMBAY ABRARI ACT, 1878.7

229A. (1) Until provision to the contrary is made by the "[Parliament by law], Saving for the "[State] Government may continue to levy any duty to which this section applies duties being levied at which it was lawfully levying immediately before the commencement of 5[the Con-commence stitution] under this Chapter as then in force. ment of "[the

(2) The duties to which this section applies are-

(a) any duty on intoxicants which are not excisable articles within the meaning of this Act; and

(b) any duty on an excisable article produced outside India and imported into the "[State] whether across a customs frontier as defined by the Central Government or not.

(3) Nothing in this section shall authorise the levy by the 4[State] Government of any duty which, as between goods manufactured or produced in the "[State] and similar goods not so manufactured or produced, discriminates in favour of the former.

BOMBAY ACT No. XII OF 1912.1

[THE BOMBAY ABKABI (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1912.]

[7th September 1912]

An Act further to amond the Bombay Abkari Act, 1878.*

Bom. WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Bombay Abkari Act, 1878, in 1878. manner hereinafter appearing;

And whereas the previous sanction of the Governor General required by section 5 of the Indian Councils Act, 1892, has been obtained for the passing of this Act; It is hereby enacted as follows :---

1-41. [Amendments made by sections 1 to 41 have been incorporated in the principal Act.]

XVI 42. "The Excise (Spirits) Act, 1863," shall be repealed as to the Presidency Local repeal of of Bombay. 1863.
