## BOMBAY ACT No. 11 OF 1955.1

## [The Bonday Repracing and Amending Act, 1965.]

[16th March 1955]

## 'An Act to repeal certain enactment and to amend certain other enactments.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal certain enactment and to amend certain other enactments for the purposes hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted in the Sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be called the Bombay Repealing and Amending Act, 1955. Short wite.
- 2. The enactment specified in the First Schedule is hereby repealed to the Repeal of extent mentioned in the fourth column thereof.
- 3. The enactments specified in the Second Schedule are hereby amended to Amendment the extent and in the manner mentioned in the fourth column thereof.
