[THE BOMBAY ABOLITION OF WHIPPING ACT, 1957.]

[28th September 1957]

An Act to provide for the abolition of whipping as a punishment in the State of Bombay.

XLIV WHEREAS Parliament has enacted the Abolition of Whipping Act, 1955, for the purpose of the abolition of whipping as a punishment;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the abolition of whipping as a punishment in the State of Bombay and for that purpose to repeal the Bombay (Emergency Powers) Whipping Act, 1947 and further to amend the BombayPrevention of Prostitution Act, 1923 and also the Prisons Act, 1894 in the areas in the State to which it extends but excluding the Saurashtra area; It is hereby enacted in the Eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :--

1. This Act may be called the Bombay Abolition of Whipping Ast, 1957. Short title.

2. The Bombay (Emergency Powers) Whipping Act, 1947, is hereby repealed Repeal of Bom. XXVII of 1947.

3. In the Bombay Prevention of Prostitution Act, 1923,-

(1) in each of the following, that is to say, in sub-section (1) of section 5, $\frac{5}{and}$ deletion sections 6 and 7 and sub-section (1) of section 8, for the words "or with whipping, of section 8A or with any two of those punishments" the words "or with both" shall be of Bom. XI substituted;

(2) section 8A shall be deleted.

4. In the Prisons Act, 1894,—
(1) in section 46,—
clause (12) shall be deleted; and in the proviso thereto, the words "or tion 53 of Act IX of 1894.

(2) in section 47, in sub-section (1), clause (4) shall be deleted;

(3) in section 50, in sub-section (1) the words "or of whipping", shall be deleted;

(4) in section 51, in sub-section (2) the words beginning with the words "and, in the case of offences" and ending with the words "reasons therefor" shall be deleted;

(5) section 53 shall be deleted.
