IT IS HEREBY enacted in the Twenty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries Board (Amendment) Act, 1976.

Short title.

2. In section 32 of the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries Board Act, 1960, in sub-section (2), in clause (d), the words "to the extent of the fund and properties of the Board vested in it" shall be *omitted*.

It IS HEREBY enacted in the Forty-third Year of the Republic of India
as follows :—

Short title

1. This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village
Industries Board (Amendment) Act, 1992.

2. In section 2 of the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries
Board Act, 1960, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, for clause
(ii-a) the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

“(ii-a) ‘Chief Executive Officer’ and ‘Additional Chief Executive
Officer’ means respectively the Chief Executive Officer and the
Additional Chief Executive Officer of the Board appointed under
section 10 :”

3. In section 5 of the principal Act, in sub-section (1), —

(a) for clause (ii), the following clause shall be *substituted*, namely:—

“(iii) Secretary to the Government of Uttar Pradesh incharge of Khadi and Village Industries, or his nominee not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary : ” ;

(b) after clause (v), the following clauses shall be *inserted*, namely:—

“(v-a) Secretary to the Government of Uttar Pradesh in the Planning Department or his nominee not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary;

(v-b) Chief Executive Officer or, if he is already a member of the Board in another capacity, the Additional Chief Executive Officer ; ”.

4. In section 10 of the principal Act, in sub-section (1), after clause

IT IS HEREBY enacted in the Fifty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

1. This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries Board (Amendment) Act, 2008. Short title

2. In section 5 of the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries Board Act, 1960, hereinafter referred to as the principal Act, for sub-section (2) the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:—

“(2) The State Government shall appoint a Vice-Chairman from amongst non-official members.”

3. In section 6-A of the principal Act, in sub-section (1) for the words “two years” the words “one year” shall be substituted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries Board Act, 1960 (U.P. Act no. 10 of 1960) provides that the State Government shall appoint a full time Vice-Chairman from amongst non-official members in consultation with the Chairman of the Khadi and Village Industries Commission established under the Khadi and Village Industries Commission Act, 1956 and sub-section (1) of section 6-A *Inter alia* provides that a non-official member of the Board shall hold office for a period of two years unless his term is determined earlier by the State Government by the notification in the *Gazette*. On the recommendation of the Khadi and Village Industries Commission it has been decided to amend section 5 of the said Act to provide for empowering the State Government to appoint a Vice-Chairman from amongst non-official members instead of full time Vice-Chairman. In order to ensure that the Board should get maximum benefit of able and qualified persons it has also been decided to reduce the term of non-official members from “two years” to “one year”.

The Uttar Pradesh Khadi and Village Industries Board (Amendment) Bill, 2008 is introduced accordingly.
