THE BOMBAY PUBLIC AUTHORITIES SEALS ACT, 1883.]

## An Act to enable Government to prescribe the Official Seals of Sessions Judges, Magistrates and other public authorities.

WHEREAS it is expedient to enable the Government to prescribe what official seals 2\* public authorities \* shall have and use; It is enacted as follows :-

- 1. This Act may be called the Bombay Public Authorities Seals Act, 1883. Short title \*1A. This Act extends to the whole of the State of Maharashtra.] Extent.
- 2. Bombay Act II of 1870 is hereby repealed. Every notification issued under Repeal of the said Act and now in force shall be deemed to have been issued under this Act. Bom. Act II of 1870.
- 3. The [5 State] Government], may, from time to time, by notification in [State] Government the [Official Gazette], direct what official seals "each of the following empowered te public authorities shall have and use (namely):prescribe the

(1) Sessions Judges, Additional and Joint Sessions Judges and Assistant seals of certain Sessions Judges: public authorities.

- (2) Presidency Magistrates;
- (3) any other Magistrates;
- (4) any other judicial officer or public authority, whose official seal is not prescribed by law and no other authority is legally competent to prescribe.

Every such notification may from time to time be modified or rescinded by the <sup>4</sup>[<sup>5</sup>[State] Government] by a like notification.

4. Every notification made under the last preceding section shall come into Date on force on such date as the 4[5[State] Government] shall therein fix in this which behalf.
