THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY AND THE INDIAN REGISTRATION (BOMBAY AMENDMENT) ACT, 1939.]

[15th June 1939]

Amended by Bom. 17 of 1945*

An Act to amend the Transfer of Property Act, 1882², and the Indian Registration Act. 1908^t, in their application to the Province of Bombay.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, and the Indian Registration Act, 1908, in their application to the Province of Bombay for the purposes hereinafter appearing ; It is hereby enacted as follows :----

1. This Act may be called the Transfer of Property and the Indian Registration short title. (Bombay Amendment) Act, 1939.

2. This Act shall apply to notices in respect of suits or proceedings which relate Application to immovable properties situate wholly or partly in ³[the Greater Bombay] with of Act. effect from such date as may be directed by the Provincial Government in this behalf by notification in the Official Gazette :

Provided that the Provincial Government may by similar notification direct that the provisions of this Act shall apply to such notices relating to immovable properties situate wholly or partly in such other area as may be specified in the said notification.

3. Section 52 of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, shall be renumbered as Amendment 1V of sub-section (1) of section 52 of the said Act and Tost.

of section 52

(i) in sub-section (1) so renumbered after the word "question", the words and 1882. figures " if a notice of the pendency of such suit or proceeding is registered under section 18 of the Indian Registration Act, 1908", and after the word property "where it occurs for the second time, the words "after the notice is so registered ", shall be inserted ; and

(ii) after the said sub-section (1) so renumbered the following shall be inserted, namely :---

"(2) Every notice of pendency of a suit or proceeding referred to in subsection (1) shall contain the following particulars, namely :--

(a) the name and address of the owner of immovable property or other person whose right to the immovable property is in question ;

(b) the description of the immovable property, the right to which is in question ;

(c) the court in which the suit or proceeding is pending;

(d) the nature and title of the suit or proceeding; and

(e) the date on which the suit or proceeding was instituted. "

Amendment of sections 18 and 28 of Act XVI of 1908. In the Indian Registration Act, 1908,-

(1) in section 18—

(i) the word " and " after clause (e) shall be deleted ; and

(ii) after clause (e) the following shall be inserted, namely :---

"(ce) notices of pending suits or proceedings referred to in section 52 of 17 of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882; and "; and

(2) in section 28 for the brackets, letters and word "(b) and (c)", the brackets, letters and word "(b), (c) and (ee)", shall be substituted.

BOMBAY ACT No. LVII OF 1959.1

[THE TRANSFER OF PROPERTY (BOMBAY PROVISION FOR UNIFORMITY AND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1959.]

[14th October 1959]

An Act to provide for uniformity in the provisions of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 in its application to the State of Bombay and further to amend the said Act.

WHEREAS in so far as the transfer of agricultural land is concerned, the Transfer IV of of Property Act, 1882 applies only to the pre-Reorganisation State of Bombay. excluding the transferred territories, the Vidarbha region and the Kutch area, but does not apply to the Saurashtra and Hyderabad areas of the State of Bombay ;

AND WHEREAS in the Saurashtra area, the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 IV of as adapted and applied to that area by the State of Saurashtra (Application of 1882. Sau. Central and Bombay Acts) Ordinance, 1948, and, in the Hyderabad area, the Ord. Hyderabad Act I of 1336 Basli are respectively in force in relation to transfer XXV of of agricultural land; 1948.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for uniformity in the provisions of the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 in its application to the entire State of Bombay IV of and to repeal the Acts mentioned in the preceding paragraph ; 1882.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to extend to rest of the State of Bombay the Bom. XIV Transfer of Property and the Indian Registration (Bombay Amondment) Act, 1939, of in so far as it amends the Transfer of Property Act, 1882 ; 1939. TV of 1882.

AND WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Transfer of Property IV of Act, 1882 in its application to the State of Bombay for the purposes hereinafter 1882. appearing;

It is hereby enacted in the Tenth Year of the Republic of India as follows :---

1. This Act may be called the Transfer of Property (Bombay Provision for Short title. Uniformity and Amendment) Act, 1959.

2. Amendment of Act IV of 1882.

Application of Act to transfer of agricultural land in Saurashtra and Hyderabad areas of State of Bombay. "1A. Subject to the provisions of any special or local law relating to agricultural land for the time being in force in any area, this Act shall, on the commencement of the Transfer of Property (Bombay Provision for Uniformity and Amend-Bom. ment) Act, 1959, apply also to transfer of agricultural land in the Saurashtra and LVII Hyderabad areas of the State of Bombay."

4. In the Transfer of Property Act, 1882, in its application to the State of IV of

Bombay (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") after section 1, the 1882.

Repeal and savings.

5. The Transfer of Property Act, 1882 as adapted and applied to the Saurashtra IV of area of the State of Bombay by the State of Saurashtra (Application of Central 1882, and Bombay Acts) Ordinance, 1948 and the Hyderabad Act I of 1336 Fasli in its Sau. application to the Hyderabad area of the State of Bombay are hereby repealed : Ord.

Provided that such repeal shall not affect-

and any such legal proceeding or remedy may be instituted, continued or enforced as if this Act had not been passed :

Provided further that, subject to the preceding proviso, anything done or any action taken under any such law shall, in so far as it is not inconsistent with the provisions of the principal Act, as amended by this Act be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of the principal Act as amended by this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything done or any action taken under the principal Act.

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
