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# MAHARASHTRA ACT No. XLV OF 19971

[THE MAHARASHTRA TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF MINOR FOREST PRODUCE IN THE SCHEDULED AREAS AND THE MAHARASHTRA MINOR FOREST PRODUCE (REGULATION OF TRADE) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1997.]

[This Act received the assent of the Governor on the 28th December 1997; assent first published in the *Maharashtra Government Gazette*, Part IV, Extraordinary, on the 29th December 1997.]

An Act to make provisions for transfer of ownership of Minor Forest Produce in the Schedule Areas, and to amend the Maharashtra Minor Forest Produce (Regulation of Trade) Act, 1969.

WHEREAS both Houses of the State Legislature were not in session;

Mah. AND WHEREAS the Governor of Maharashtra was satisfied that circumstances LVII existed which rendered it necessary for him to take immediate action to make provious for transfer of ownership of Minor Forest Produce in the Scheduled Areas and to amend the Maharashtra Minor Forest Produce (Regulation of Trade) Act, Ord. 1969, for the purposes hereinafter appearing; and therefore, promulgated the XIX Maharashtra Transfer of Ownership of Minor Forest Produce in the Scheduled of Areas and the Maharashtra Minor Forest Produce (Regulation of Trade) (Amend-1997, ment) Ordinance, 1997, on the 10th day of December 1997;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to replace the said Ordinance by an Act of the State Legislature; It is hereby enacted in the Forty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

# CHAPTER I

### PRELIMINARY

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Maharashtra Transfer of Ownership of Minor Short title Forest Produce in the Scheduled Areas and the Maharashtra Minor Forest Produce and commencement (Regulation of Trade) (Amendment) Act, 1997.
  - (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 10th December 1997.

# CHAPTER II

TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF MINOR FOREST PRODUCE TO PANCHAYATS IN SCHEDULED AREAS

- 2. This Chapter shall apply to the *Panchayats* in the Scheduled Areas in the State Applications. of Maharashtra, referred to in clause (1) of Article 244 of the Constitution of India.
  - 3. In this Chapter, unless the context otherwise requires,—

Definitions.

- (a) "minor forest produce" means forest produce specified in the Schedule appended to this Chapter;
- 45 of (b) "public servant" means a person as defined in section 21 of the Indian 1860. Penal Code;
  - (c) "Schedule" means the Schedule to this Chapter, and the State Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, add to or modify the same, after considering the necessity for such addition or modification in the public interest.

Every such notification shall be laid before each House of the State Legislature. as soon as may be, after it is issued and shall be subject to such modifications as the State Legislature may, make during the session in which it is so laid, and published in the Official Gazette, as modified by the State Legislature;

- (d) "Working Plan" or "Management Plan" or "Working Scheme" means a document of technical nature approved by a competent authority appointed by the State Government or the Central Government, as the case may be, laying the prescriptions for scientific management of specified forest area;
- (e) all words and expressions used in this Chapter but not defined herein shall have the meanings, respectively, as assigned to them in the Bombay Village Bom. III of Panchayats Act, 1958. 1959.

Ownership in Panchayat.

- 4. (1) The ownership of minor forest produce found in the Government lands of Minor in the Scheduled Areas, excluding the National Parks and Sanctuaries, shall vest in Forest Pro- the Panchayat within whose jurisdiction such area falls.
  - Explanation.—The expressions "National Parks" and "Sanctuaries" used in 53 of this section shall have the same meanings respectively, assigned to them under the 1972. Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972.
  - (2) For removal of doubts, it is declared that the ownership of minor forest produce shall not include the ownership of land or trees in that *Panchavat* area and 16 of the same shall be governed by the provisions of the Indian Forest; Act, 1927.
  - (3) If any dispute arises regarding the ownership of minor forest produce among the Panchayats, the decision of the State Government shall be final.

(2) Whoever contravenes or violates the prescriptions contained in the Working Plan or Plan or the Management Plan or the Working Scheme or the rules made by the Working Conservator of Forest of the concerned Circle shall, on conviction, be punished Scheme with fine which may extend to rupees five thousand or with imprisonment which may extend to one year or with both.

- 6. (1) No suit, prosecution or other legal proceedings shall lie against any respect of public servant for anything which is in good faith done or intended to be so done in good faith, pursuance of the provisions of this Chapter.
  - (2) No suit or other legal proceedings shall lie against the State Government for any damage caused or likely to be caused or any injury suffered or likely to be suffered, by virtue of the provisions of this Chapter or by anything which is done in good faith or intended to be so done in pursuance of the provisions of this Chapter.

7. (1) The provisions of this Chapter shall be in addition to and shall not be Panchayats, in derogation of, the provisions of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, and the Wildlife 16 of and (Protection) Act, 1972, and all the penal provisions obtaining in the said Act shall 1927. of Indian also apply to all the Panchayats to which this Chapter applies. 53 of Forests Act,

(2) If the person committing an offence under this Chapter is a *Panchayat*, every 1927 and Wildlife person who, at the time the offence was committed, was in charge of, and was (Protection) responsible to, the Panchayat for the exercise of the powers and conduct of the Act, 1972 to functions and duties of the Panchayar shall also be liable to be proceeded against apply, and punished accordingly.

## CHAPTER III

"(e) "Forest Produce" means such forest produce as defined under the Indian 16 of Forest Act, 1927 as are specified in the Schedule appended to this Act, and the 1927. State Government may, from time to time, by notification in the Official Gazette. add to or modify the Schedule in the public interest, and the provisions of subsection (3) of section 19 in so far as they relate to laying before and modification. as they apply in relation to any rule made under that section shall apply in relation to such notification;".

# CHAPTER IV

# MISCELLANEOUS.

13. If any doubt or difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of this Act. remove the State Government may, by order, give such direction, not inconsistent with doubts and difficulties, the provisions of this Act, as may appear to it to be necessary or expedient for the removal of the doubt or difficulty:

> Provided that, no such order shall be made after expiry of a period of two years from the date of commencement of this Act.

14. (1) The Maharashtra Transfer of Owenership of Minor Forest Produce in Mah. Repeal of Mah. Ord. the Scheduled Areas and the Maharashtra Minor Forest Produce (Regulation of Ord. XIX of Total (Annual) Ordinary 1997 in hearthy repealed 1997 and Trade) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1997, is hereby repealed. 1997. saving.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken (including any notification issued or rules made or decision taken) under the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done, taken, issued or made, as the case may be, under the corresponding provisions of this Act.
