The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 20th December, 1990 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 27th December, 1990 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:-

Act No. 27 of 1990.

An Act further to amend the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Land Revenue Act, 1317 Faali.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Forty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short title. 1. This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Land Revenue (Amendment) Act, 1990.

Insertion of new Section 166-C Act VIII of 1317 Fasli. 2. After section 166B of the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Land Revenue Act, 1317 Fasli, the following section shall be inserted, namely:-

Government.

(1) The Government may, at any time, either *ex* *moto*, or on application from any person interested, made within ninety days of the passing of an order under section 158 or section 166B review any such order if it was passed by them under any mistake, whether of fact or of law, or in ignorance of any material fact:

Provided that the Government shall not pass any order adversely affecting the interests of any person unless such person has been given an opportunity of making his representation.

(2) The Government may stay the execution of any such decision or order, pending the exercise of their powers under sub-section (1) in respect thereof.

(3) The provisions of this section shall apply to any order passed under section 158 or section 166B whether before or after the commencement of the Andhra Pradesh (Telangana Area) Land Revenue (Amendment) Act, 1990 and in the case of an application for review from any person interested in respect of such an order passed prior

to such commencement, the period of ninety days specified in sub-section (1) shall be computed from the date of such commencement."
