*to amend the Uttar Pradesh Weights and Measures (Enforcement)
Act, 1959*

It is hereby enacted in the Thirteenth Year of the Republic
of India as follows :

1. (1) This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Bat tatha
Map (Prachalan) (Sanshodhan) Adhiniyam, 1962.

Short title extent
and commence-
ment.

(2) This Act, except section 5 thereof, shall come into force
atonce and the said section 5 shall come into force on such date
as the State Government may, by notification in the *Gazette*,
appoint in this behalf.

2. In section 2 of the Uttar Pradesh Weights and Measures
(Enforcement) Act, 1959 (hereinafter called the principal Act)—

(i) after clause (j) the following new clause shall be
inserted—

“(jj) ‘use in transactions for trade or commerce’
means use for or in connection with any transaction for—

(i) the transferring or rendering of money’s
worth for consideration, or

(ii) the making of a payment in respect of any
toll or duty,

being a transaction in connection with which there is
made a determination or declaration of quantity in
terms of measurement of length, area, volume, capacity
or weight” ; and

(ii) in clause (l) for the words “steel yards” the word
“steelyards” shall be substituted.

Passed in Hindi by the Uttar Pradesh Legislative Council on September 25,
1962, and by the Uttar Pradesh Legislative Assembly on November 1, 1962.

Extraordinary*, dated Ferbuary 1, 1963.

3. In section 3 of the principal Act—

(a) in sub-section (1), the words “and special sets of working standards in relation to bullion and precious stones may also be prepared” shall be deleted; and

(b) in sub-section (4), the colon shall be substituted by a fullstop and the proviso thereto shall be deleted.

Amendment of
section 10 of U.P.
Act no. V of 1959.

4. For section 10 of the principal Act, the following shall be substituted:

Prohibition of
sale or use of
unstamped commercial
weights and measures.

“10. No weight or measure or weighing or measuring instrument shall be used in any transaction for trade or commerce or be sold or delivered for such use unless it has been verified or reverified in the manner prescribed and stamped in the prescribed manner by an Inspector with stamp of verification.”

5. In sections 12 and 25 of the principal Act the word “commercial” shall be deleted.

Amendment of
sections 20 and
43 of U. P. Act
no. V of 1959.

6. In clause (a) of section 20 and in clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 43 the word “commercial” shall be deleted.
